Keep it tangle free! They may be made of plastic, but tarps, shower curtains, extension cords, hoses and ropes don't belong in your recycling bin. They get caught in the recycling equipment. If they are in good condition, try donating them. If not, they belong in the trash.

Only the clean part (usually just the top) of a pizza box is recyclable. Throw the rest of it in the trash or backyard compost bin if you have one. Find a place to recycle your cardboard at RecycleSpot.org.

That lightweight foam wrap that is sometimes used to protect new furniture and electronics is made of #4 polyethylene—the same resin used in plastic grocery bags. You know what that means?
