EXCELSIOR SPRINGS ENTERPRISE ZONE NOTIFICATION Staff presented a letter from the City of Excelsior Springs saying they are moving forward with plans to create a new Enhanced Enterprise Zone to stimulate economic development and business recruitment activities.
